Korea International Cooperation Agency (KOICA) is seeking collaboration opportunities through the **2024 KOICA Joint Fellowship Program CIAT** (Capacity Improvement & Advancement for Tomorrow).

If your Agency is interested in this Joint Fellowship Program, please suggest the concept and provide the relevant information with the enclosed PCP template. PCP and cover letter are to be submitted from your Agency to the Embassy of Republic of Korea by no later than **14 October 2022**. Please kindly refer to the guideline of the program as below.

- PCPs are recommended to target multi-countries, with duration of 2 to 3 years, and designed with a total budget of USD 100,000 to 150,000 per year including any indirect cost
- PCPs covers following sectors will be preferred in screening process:
Green, Science·Technology·ICT, universal value of human rights, human security including but not limited to health, food security, and peace
- PCPs and cover letter shall be submitted by the Agency through the Embassy or Permanent Mission of the Republic of Korea. In the case of preparing joint PCP in cooperation with KOICA, the PCPs still require to be submitted by the Agency as an indication of agreement to the PCP concept.

Once PCPs are received, the Government of the Republic of Korea and National Assembly will review and screen the PCPs and the result will be informed by January 2024.
