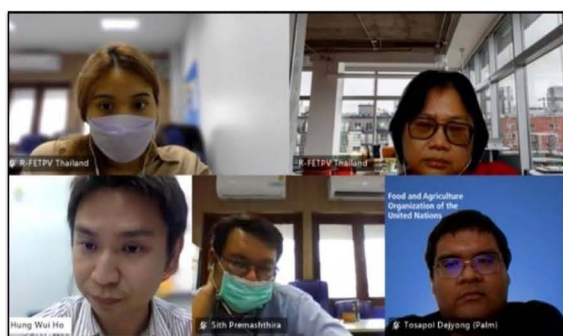

2. Announcement of The 1st Module of R-FETPV 2022: "Basic Epidemiology and Surveillance Data Analysis"



The 1st Module of R-FETPV 2022 was announced to the target countries including ASEAN, and South Asia in the early January 2022. The online applicant interviewing was done by selection committee comprising of R-FETPV and FAORAP team.

Eleven trainees have been selected to attend the 1st Module of R-FETPV 2022 including six international and five Thai trainees.

The training will start from 9 June to 28 July 2022 as an in-person training at FETP and R-FETPV, Thailand unless any update announcements on travel restrictions due to the COVID-19 outbreak concerned.
